⇒ Over 2,000 nights of shelter were provided to victims of domestic violence or sexual abuse by Friends of Abused Families

⇒ 500 people a month obtained emergency food from Full Shelf Food Pantry

⇒ 103 youth gained skills to prevent future runaway episodes through the Youth & Family Project

⇒ 116 Juvenile offenders fulfilled their restitution obligation by working with Nova Services
