AGENCY OVERVIEW

Donna Lexa Community Art Center was established in 1985 to provide art programs for students with disabilities that would provide an environment of creative expression. The program nurtures artistic creativity and expression with individuals experiencing physical or other types of health conditions. It provides fine art instruction in community centers, participating hospitals, and numerous outreach sites. As much choice as possible is left to the student for project selection and artistic expression. Materials and special adaptations are included in a class fee.

The Donna Lexa Community Art Program became a United Way of Washington County member agency in 2007. It also receives funding from the United Way of Waukesha and is not affiliated with any national organization.
