WHEREAS; last year, Wisconsin citizens generously contributed their time and talents, as well as more than \$123 million to the United Way, thereby investing in stronger communities; and


WHEREAS; the United Way kicks off its annual campaign every fall in order to support those efforts;

throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.


