In 2022, Washington County saw a total of 3,658 calls to IMPACT 211 for mental health services. Access to individual counseling services is a critical need for the community. To help address this need, the United Way is investing in two agencies to provide mental health counseling services to youth for 2023.

In 2019 United Way's Vision Council identified mental health as a top priority. The pandemic increased the need for services and funding was directed to youth to receive individual counseling services and group therapy. The funding also addresses the need for additional counselors to deal with a shortage of providers.
